Bladder and Bowel Health

- **Bladder Dysfunction in Adults**

This course provides an opportunity to gain knowledge of different types and causes of lower urinary tract dysfunction, assessment strategies and treatment / management options.

- **Bowel Dysfunction in Adults**

This course is facilitated by a Clinical Specialist Nurse. It covers: anatomy and physiology of the bowel, assessment skills, management of constipation and faecal incontinence, neurogenic bowel management, autonomic dysreflexia, use of laxatives and other medications, procedures for Digital Rectal Examination (DRE), Digital Removal of Faeces (DRF) and Digital Rectal Stimulation (DRS), rectal irrigation.

- **Catheterisation**

This course is for practitioners managing patients with indwelling catheters. It aims to develop competence in management of catheterisation. It covers: ANTT procedure for female and male catheterisation (via DVD), infection control, safe practice, problem solving, documentation, simulated practice using catheterisation models.

- **Continence Awareness**

This course aims to increase understanding of bladder and bowel continence dysfunction. It covers local and national guidance, prescribing of containment products, continence care and use of assessment tools as well as signs and symptoms of catheter associated urinary tract infections.

Excellence in Continence And Catheter Care E-Learning

This is provided as 2 modules 1) Promoting best practice in continence care 2) Promoting best practice in catheter care. This e-learning was developed by Oxford Academic Health Science Network in partnership with Health Education England for staff in all care settings to improve knowledge and awareness of all aspects of continence and catheter care. The sessions should be used as an adjunct to face-to-face teaching sessions.

Cancer

Cancer Training by Macmillan Cancer Support

A range of training courses are available provided by Macmillan Cancer Support, such as Cancer Awareness and Communication Training for Reception and Non-Clinical Staff, Cancer Prevention, Screening and Early Diagnosis and Cancer course for the Primary Care Team.

Cancer in the Community E-learning

This course is delivered by E-learning for Health. The programme aims to ensure knowledge for community-based workers related to the key aspects of cancer and its treatment becomes embedded into their daily activities, and aims to inspire them to support clients before, during and after cancer is diagnosed.

GatewayC Online Platform

GatewayC is an online cancer education platform developed for GPs, practice nurses, GPs in training, health care assistants, physician associates and other primary care professionals across England.

Macmillan webinars

Provided by Red Whale and Macmillan Cancer Support, this is a series of webinars where several consultant oncologists are quizzed to demystify some of the conundrums posed by cancer in primary care.

Cardio-Vascular Training

● ● ● NEW Cardiovascular Training Pathway

We have just launched a series of modules aimed at both registered and non-registered health care professionals, covering:

- anatomy and physiology
- hypertension and cardiovascular risk
- cardiac heart disease
- heart failure
- stroke

The modules will be underpinned with a set of competencies. On completion the learner will have developed a foundation of knowledge to enable them to complete a review of patients at their own level of practice.

Managing Hypertension in Primary Care

- For practice nurses and non-medical prescribers, this training will cover new diagnosis, how to treat hypertension, lifestyle interventions, first steps into drug management and medication management.

Managing Raised BP Reading and Hypertension

- The overall aim of this training is to upskill Health Care Assistants and newly qualified nurses to feel confident about BP targets, how to respond to raised BPs and to provide lifestyle interventions that can reduce risk.

Performing ECGs

In order to ensure that ECGs are performed competently and safely, we have a recommended learning path which includes self-directed learning, followed by an interactive learning session and competency sign off.

Anaphylaxis E-learning

Provided by E-learning for Health, this learning resource has been written to meet the needs of a wide variety of health care professionals such as health care support workers, registered practitioners and medical staff in both the community and hospital setting.

Basic Life Support (BLS) – Adult Resuscitation E-learning

This course is delivered by E-learning for Health and meets the statutory and mandatory training requirements and learning outcomes for Resuscitation Adult Level 2 in the UK Core Skills Training Framework (UK CSTF). We can also signpost you to providers of face-to-face Basic Life Support training.

Cardiovascular Disease Prevention (All Our Health) E-Learning

This is a bite-sized session to give health and care professionals an overview of cardiovascular disease – including key evidence, data and signposting to trusted resources to help prevent illness, protect health and promote wellbeing.

Clinical Assessment and Diagnostics

- **Interpretation of Common Blood Test Results**

An advanced level interactive course delivered by GP lecturer, for experienced practitioners. Understand clinical implications of routine full blood count and biochemistry test results. Includes renal, liver, endocrine, calcium metabolism, inflammatory markers. The course uses real blood results for focus of discussion and students are encouraged to bring their own anonymised examples.

Clinical Skills.Net

The Training Hub has purchased licences for primary care staff to access Clinical Skills.net, an online clinical procedures manual/educational resource to support training and best practice. This provides in excess of 350 clinical procedure guides presented in a clear, illustrated step-by-step format, aligned with current best practice and fully referenced.

Venepuncture

The provision of skills training for obtaining venous blood samples from the arm. This course provides theory and practice to gain competence, under clinical supervision of a practitioner in your workplace.

- ● **Verification of Death**

The overall aim of the session is to educate, train and assess registered nurses in verifying death, by underpinning it with a base knowledge of the law (national and local policies).

Dermatology

- **Dermatology in Primary Care**

Using images and case-based teaching, this day is designed to start the process of identifying and managing skin conditions, building confidence and developing an approach that is based on understanding.

Diabetes Training

● ● ● **NEW!! Primary Care Diabetes Skills & Confidence (DiSkCo) Builder**

This offers individuals, teams and networks a comprehensive tool to assess diabetes competencies for each member of staff delivering the diabetes clinical service. The tool links to relevant training options to close competency gaps. It provides a simple route to identifying and meeting upskilling needs for PCN diabetes services. Our Diabetes Training Programme is a virtually delivered theory-based programme, supported by optional in-practice mentorship. It covers introduction, diabetes annual review, nutrition, lifestyle management and oral and injectable therapies. The individual study sessions are tailored to all team members and their requirements.

● **Beginners Guide to Diabetes**

This training supports development of new models of care delivery and is particularly suitable for health care support workers and registered professionals new to diabetes who are becoming more involved in delivering diabetes care. It covers foundational knowledge of what diabetes is as well as covering all components of annual review and essential aspects of person-centred care in diabetes.

● ● **Diabetes MERIT Courses**

Developed by Novo Nordisk, the aim of the programme is to support the development of skills and competency in the management of Type 2 Diabetes in the primary care setting in line with TREND competencies. Modules available are as follows:

- Pre-Insulin Treatment Options for the Management of Type2 diabetes
- Insulin Initiation for people with Type 2 Diabetes
- Insulin Management for people with Type 2 Diabetes

● **Diabetic Foot Training**

This training, delivered by the local specialist podiatry team, provides an overview of diabetic foot disease, how to identify the 'at risk' foot and who, when and where to refer. It is particularly appropriate for HCA's/technicians undertaking foot screening in diabetes.

Lifestyle Support for People at Risk at or Living with Type 2 Diabetes

This lunch and learn session will focus on what lifestyle support is available for people who are at risk of or living with diabetes and have a BMI above a healthy weight. Sessions are delivered by NHS Kernow and Healthy Cornwall.

● ● Understanding ‘Diabetes & You’ (how to support self-management for Type-2 Diabetes)

This module equips health care staff in primary care with essential skills to support diabetes patient self-management. The module explores participants experiences of promoting self-management and covers key messages for diabetes conversations and consultations, including dietary advice to support newly-diagnosed, and those who have had diabetes for some time.

● ● ● Cambridge Diabetes Education Programme E-Learning

This is a competency-based programme with multiple topics which individuals can select. The programme offers competency assessment with accompanying resources to support knowledge of relevant national and international clinical guidelines.

● Diabetes Foot Screening (FRAME) E-Learning

The Foot Risk Awareness and Management Education learning resource is relevant to all health care disciplines involved in this aspect of diabetes care and aims to help standardise diabetes foot screening. This e-learning can be used independently but ideally complements and consolidates the foot care training course.

● ● ● Insulin Safety: Getting It Right E-Learning

This elearning module, written by Trend Diabetes, hosted by Skills Platform, has been designed to help reduce the errors in the prescription and administration of insulin

Diet, Nutrition and Weight Management

- **Malnutrition**

Malnutrition is an under recognised condition with far reaching health consequences, affecting 11% of patients in GP practices. This training covers screening, first line nutrition advice and oral nutritional supplements.

Nutritional Screening: A MUST for Healthcare Workers E-learning

Developed in partnership between BAPEN and Greater Glasgow and Clyde NHS these three modules explain the causes and consequences of malnutrition, the importance of nutritional screening and how to screen using 'MUST'.

Obesity, Nutrition and Weight Management E-Learning

Provided by E-Learning for Health, the Obesity e-learning course is designed to help GPs and other primary care clinicians develop the knowledge and skills necessary to address obesity when presented in a primary care setting. They also provide a Healthier Weight Competency Framework to help learners to assess their develop needs and signpost to relevant resources.

End of Life Care

Cornwall and Isles of Scilly End of Life Learning Path

The Cornwall & Isles of Scilly End of Life Learning Path is available across the entire health and social care community and as such, it has been developed to guide and support staff working in both primary, secondary and social care. The electronic learning path is supported by a hand-held passport which provides a platform for discussion and evidence of the learning achieved.

ENT

- ● **Ear Care & Irrigation**

This training has been developed by the Rotherham Primary Care Ear Centre and is delivered by an accredited trainer for the South West. Content covers best practice in assessment and treatment of minor ear problems, including correct procedure for safe irrigation.

- ● **Ear Care Update**

This study session is an update for nurses and HCAs who have previously attended the ear care study days and practice ear irrigation.

- **ENT in the Community**

This will be a problem-based day focussing on common ENT problems in the community. ENT issues are common and varied. This day will have space for you to bring your learning needs and cases for discussion.

Immunisation

NB: for all immunisation training staff should ensure that their anaphylaxis skills and Hepatitis B vaccination is up to date.

- **Foundation for Health Care Support Workers**

This course is designed for healthcare support workers (HCSWs) who have achieved or are currently undertaking education and training to Level Three of the Qualifications and Credit Framework (QCF) 4 or equivalent with at least 2 years' experience as a HCSW. This course is delivered via e-learning, highly directed study and an interactive virtual session after which competency must be assessed in practice.

- ● **Foundation for Registered Health Care Professionals**

This course is suitable for registered HCP's (nurses, pharmacists, paramedics). This course is delivered via e-learning, highly directed study and an interactive virtual session. After this session you will then be expected to have competency documents signed in practice with an appropriately qualified assessor before being deemed competent to administer vaccines.

- ● **Foundation in Travel Health**

The requirement for this course is currently being closely monitored given the current situation with travelling abroad. This course will therefore be scheduled subject to demand.

- **Immunisation Update for Health Care Support Workers**

As recommended by Public Health England, this update is for health care support workers who have been delegated a role in immunisation by an appropriate registered HCP.

- **Immunisation Update for Registered Health Care Professionals**

This update is for registered health care professionals who administer immunisations. This Update is provided via highly directed study followed by an interactive virtual session.

- ● **Update in Travel Health**

This course is designed for those who have completed travel immunisations in the past and who require an update. In many cases, attendees may not have administered travel vaccinations for a while and require a refresher on the basics of travel medicine as well as an update on current travel health topics.

Adult Immunisation: Screening & Immunisation for Non-Clinical Staff E-learning

Another e-learning module in GP receptionist training series, this is about adult immunisations. There are four adult immunisation programmes commissioned by Public Health England. These are: Flu vaccine, Pneumococcal vaccine (given to children as well) Shingles vaccine and Pertussis (whooping cough) vaccine given to pregnant women.

Child & Adolescent: Immunisation for Non-Clinical Staff E-learning

This course is delivered by NHS England for GP Receptionists and is about child and adolescent immunisation programmes. The World Health Organisation said in 2014 that the two public health interventions that have had the greatest impact on the world's health are clean water and vaccinations, and this module describes the scope and effectiveness of the UK Childhood Immunisation Programmes.

- ● **Flu Immunisation E-Learning**

The Flu Immunisation e-learning package is designed to provide all healthcare practitioners involved in delivering the national flu immunisation programme with

the knowledge they need to confidently promote high uptake of annual seasonal flu vaccination.

● ● **Immunisation Update E-Learning**

Provided by E-Learning for Health, a suite of modules is available for those new to immunisation and those needing to update. There are 7 modules: National Immunisation Policy and Programmes, Immunology, Vaccine Preventable Diseases, Communicating with Patients, Parents and Carers, Legal Aspects, Vaccine Storage, Vaccine Administration. These modules form an essential part of the Foundation programmes for Registered Health Care Professionals and Health Care Support Workers, but can also be accessed separately.

Primary Care Immunisation Update Webinar Series 2020

The primary care immunisation update webinar series 2020 is a training resource developed and provided by UK Health Security Agency London and funded by NHS England and NHS Improvement London.

Medicines Management

● **Non-Medical Prescribing Quarterly Review and CPD**

The need for ongoing and regular CPD and update for Non-Medical Prescribers is critical. Within General Practice, we often work in relative isolation and this creates anxiety and uncertainty when making prescribing decisions. In this initiative, we are planning quarterly meetings to meet this need and create a supportive community of prescribers, addressing your needs and governance issues ensuring your CPD is relevant and targeted.

PrescQipp Medicines Use in Care Homes: Course 1- E-Learning

This e-learning supports care home staff involved in any aspect of medicines use. Students should have undertaken basic administration of medicines competency training as appropriate to their care setting prior to taking this course. This e-learning covers: role of CQC, NICE Guideline and Quality Standards, management of medicines in care homes, self-medicating residents, using inhalers, eye drop, transdermal patches, topical creams, 'when required.'

PrescQIPP Practice Medicines Co-Ordinator - E-Learning

This e-learning course is for non-clinical staff who manage repeat prescribing. This course will help improve: medicines safety, satisfaction for patients and staff, reduce

waste, make savings by containing costs. The course helps staff become a point of contact for medicines related queries and work in collaboration with medicines optimisation team. The course is most appropriate for those new or recently starting to work in managing repeat medications.

Mental Health

- **Mental Health in Primary Care**

We have a mental health crisis on our hands? How do we: stay safe? be effective ? prioritise time? make a difference? This training will cover theories around the causes of anxiety and depression, review of talking therapy, medication, brief interventional techniques in CBT.

Mental Health Training

Healthy Cornwall provide a range of training in mental health from Connect 5 to Mental Health Awareness and Suicide First Aid.

Musculoskeletal

Versus Arthritis E-Learning

Red Whale and Versus Arthritis have teamed up to offer you this series of free MSK webinars, to help build our skills and confidence in this area of primary care.

- **MSK in Primary Care (in development)**

This session will provide an update of the evidence-based assessment and management of MSK conditions within primary care including the appropriate assessment techniques and the recommended advice and information to provide. The training is appropriate for any Primary Care clinicians who are likely to have consultations with patients presenting with an MSK problem.

Non-Clinical

We provide an extensive programme of non-clinical training. **These courses are available to all staff within primary care whether you have a clinical or non-clinical role.** For further details, please go to our website or view our Prospectus for Non-Clinical Training.

Older Person Care

● ● ● **RESTORE2 Training**

RESTORE2 stands for: **R**ecognise **E**arly **S**oft **S**igns, **T**ake **O**bservations, **R**espond, **E**scalate. It is based on nationally recognised methodologies including early recognition (Soft Signs), the national early warning score (NEWS2) and structured communications (SBARD). We signpost to interactive training, e-learning and provide useful resources. This offer includes training for non-clinical staff.

Act Now (Admission Avoidance) E-learning

Provided by E-learning for Health, this programme takes the learner through a wealth of resources which highlight how individuals at every level can take personal action to help people get home from hospital sooner or prevent admission altogether.

● **Comprehensive Geriatric Assessment Toolkit**

Provided by the British Geriatrics Society, the Comprehensive Geriatric Assessment Toolkit is for General Practitioners and medical and healthcare professionals working in primary care settings.

● **Dementia Training Videos for Primary Care**

The South West Mental Health Clinical Network have produced a series of short training videos, aimed at GPs, on dementia. The purpose of these videos is to upskill and build upon existing knowledge of dementia to provide confidence to those involved in supporting patients who may be concerned, going through tests or for those who have been diagnosed with dementia.

Live Longer Better

This course, developed by Sir Muir Gray, former Chief Knowledge Officer for the NHS, demonstrates how anyone over the age of 60 should be making active changes to their lifestyle in order to live longer, better. The course will encourage you to re-examine the way you talk about and effect the process of ageing.

Paediatrics

- **Assessment and Management of the Ill Child**

The training uses case-based scenarios to consider common conditions, such as: fever, ENT, otitis media, respiratory illness, croup/RSV/pneumonia, UTI, bowel dysfunction, D+V, rashes, orthopaedic issues.

- **Paediatric Asthma**

This course will cover the epidemiology and impact of childhood asthma, the latest asthma guidance with regards to both diagnosis and treatment.

- ● ● **Coaching Conversations**

The NHS long term plan talks about a shift in the relationship with the people we support, hence we need new skills for a new kind of relationship. Instead of treating patients as passive recipients of care, they must be viewed as partners. A coaching approach enables a culture of encouraging people to be resourceful and focuses on intrinsic and extrinsic motivators. This 2-day accredited training enables participants to understand how coaching can be used effectively within a clinical or professional role, examining not only how to coach conversation skills, but also looking at when and where a coaching approach is effective.

- ● ● **Learning Disabilities Training**

For all practice staff involved in the Annual Health Checks or who want to improve their knowledge around the health needs of people with learning disabilities.

Person Centred Approaches E-Learning

Provided, by E-Learning for Health, this programme supports the Person-Centred Approaches Framework, which was developed by Skills for Health, Skills for Care and NHS Health Education England.

Social Prescriber Link Worker E-Learning

Core Training for Social Prescriber Link Workers are via E-learning for Health and comprises of a core 6 sessions which take approximately 3 hours to complete. There are a further 2 new modules available for 2021 with a further module in development. Other useful training is available. Please visit our website for more details.

Primary Care Access

Passport to Primary Care

'Passport to Primary Care' is a Cornwall Primary Care Training Hub initiative, supporting access to primary care roles for newly qualified health care professionals/returners, those with previous experience in different health care fields, alongside those interested in non-clinical roles with no prior healthcare experience. It forms an ideal opportunity to develop portfolio roles across the health care system.

The 'Passport' programme offers core and optional multi-professional introductory training modules. Participants can also select from a range of further training opportunities from the Training Hub prospectus, according to individual needs. Once skills and competencies are acquired, staff can register with the Kernow Staff Bank if desired, to acquire experience in primary care.

Public / Population Health

Domestic Abuse and Sexual Violence

The programme, written by Barnardo's, the U.K's largest children's charity and in partnership with First Light, has been commissioned by the local authority and Safer Cornwall Partnership. The training consists of three levels. Prior to booking the training, individuals should consider their professional experience, responsibility and how previous training will support the level of learning at each session.

Healthy Cornwall Training

Courses delivered by Healthy Cornwall are as follows:

Infection Prevention and Control Annual Update for Primary Care

The two-part session will run for one hour The first half for clinical and non-clinical staff and then the second half for clinical staff only. The session will provide an annual infection prevention and control update to support Cornwall primary care providers in complying with CQC requirements.

Making Every Contact Count Virtual Delivery and E-Learning

This nationally endorsed training focuses on simple interventions which can be used by any HCP to promote health enhancing behaviours, such as healthy eating, physical activity, smoking cessation, alcohol reduction. It provides useful information and key messages to pass on to patients so that HCPs are ‘Making Every Contact Count’.

Health Inequalities E-learning

This course explores health inequalities; what they are and why they matter to patients, communities and practitioners.

Long Covid E-Learning and Resources

E-learning for Health provide a Covid Recovery & Rehabilitation programme as well as a series of post-Covid webinars.

Public & Population Health Wellbeing and Prevention E-Learning

The Population Wellbeing Portal provides a central location for free training and education resources relating to the health and wellbeing of the public. Here you will find links to e-learning, toolkits, videos, webinars and various publications. Whatever your involvement with the public, these resources will support you in expanding your knowledge and skills to enable you to influence the health of the population.

Public Health – All Our Health E-Learning

This is a suite of e-learning topics created by Public Health England, covering the top current challenges facing today’s population: obesity, physical activity, antimicrobial resistance, cardio-vascular risk, healthy start to life, homelessness, social prescribing.

These topics are not only relevant to all staff working in healthcare, but to all of us as individuals. Registration on the platform allows for recording of completed modules. This forms an ideal component to induction or preceptor training.

Smoking Cessation & Training (NCSCT) E-learning

The National Centre for Smoking Cessation and Training (NCSCT) have various levels of courses on stopping smoking.

Safeguarding – Cornwall and IoS Safeguarding Partnership Trust

Cornwall and the IoS Safeguarding Partnership Training provide a range of training options. You can find further details and book on their website.

Respiratory Training

● ● An Update in Asthma

This webinar is aimed at healthcare professionals that are that are already managing asthma patients in practice and are wanting an update.

● ● An Update in COPD

This webinar is aimed at healthcare professionals that are that are already managing asthma patients in practice and are wanting an update.

● ● An Update in Spirometry – Interpretation

This 2-hour standalone webinar is aimed at healthcare professionals that have already completed training in spirometry and are interpreting it in clinical practice and require an update.

● ● An Update in Spirometry - Performing

This 2-hour standalone webinar is aimed at healthcare professionals that have already completed training in spirometry and are performing it in clinical practice and require an update.

● ● Asthma Case Study Session

This session will be case based with an opportunity to discuss delegate's own patient cases. This is an interactive participatory session that focuses on more challenging patient presentations.

- **Breathlessness and Differential Diagnosis**

This webinar is for professionals who have completed the Clinical Examination of the Chest training and who wish to consolidate their learning further through case studies.

- **Clinical Examination of the Chest**

This webinar is aimed at healthcare professionals that are both new to listening to chests or those experienced and wanting an update.

- **Clinical Assessment, Diagnosis & Management of Adult Asthma**

This advanced level course is suitable for healthcare professionals who are looking to enhance their knowledge and skills in asthma utilising the most up to date evidence-based guidance.

- **Clinical Assessment, Diagnosis & Management of COPD**

Suitable for healthcare professionals (at advanced level) who wish to improve their knowledge and skills in COPD utilising the most up to date evidence-based guidance.

- **A COPD Case Study Session**

This session will provide the opportunity to discuss patient cases with health care professionals that are already managing patients in practice. This is an interactive participatory session that focuses on a holistic approach thinking beyond the label of COPD and more at treatable traits.

- **Inhaler Devices & Techniques**

Aimed at healthcare professionals involved in the teaching and assessment of inhaler technique and those that prescribe or make respiratory treatment recommendations.

- **Paediatric Asthma**

This course will cover the epidemiology and impact of childhood asthma, the latest asthma guidance with regards to both diagnosis and treatment.

- **Respiratory Basics (Asthma & COPD)**

Facilitated by a Practice Nurse Specialist in Respiratory Care, this is a course for any healthcare professional beginning to work in respiratory care or who require an update. It covers the basics of Asthma and COPD and provides a good knowledge foundation.

● ● ● Spirometry Online Learning Package including ARTP Assessment

Education for Health provide a Spirometry Interactive Blended Online Learning package including ARTP assessment access. This course is designed for healthcare professionals who are responsible for performing, recording and interpreting spirometry in adults, or a combination of these.

● Asthma E-Learning

The e-Asthma programme is an interactive e-learning resource for healthcare professionals which aims to improve the diagnosis and management of asthma as a long-term condition for children and adults. This is a foundation level educational resource aimed at all healthcare professionals who come into contact with children or adults with asthma who are not asthma specialists.

● Inhaler Technique Staff Awareness Learning Resource

This learning resource is for all clinical staff who are in a position to observe and correct inappropriate techniques, helping to reduce potential deterioration of patients and/or patients presenting at ED.

● ● Respiratory Academy E-Learning

This e-Learning platform provides a range of short respiratory topic modules which can be used for CPD. Topics include: allergies, pulmonary rehabilitation, smoking cessation, COPD, asthma, co-morbidity management, inhalers, patient self-management, assessment, diagnostic tests, spirometry. E-Learning can be studied independently but also complements Training Hub face to face respiratory courses.

● Respiratory Education to Support Professionals E-Learning

This course is delivered by RESPE (Respiratory Education to Support Professionals through E-Learning). This is a free, interactive, e-learning resource which provides a basic knowledge of common respiratory conditions. The aim of the resource is to improve patient/client care by increasing the knowledge and skills of any member of health and social care staff working with people living with respiratory conditions in health, social or private care settings.

● ● Respiratory Surge in Children Programme E-Learning

These resources are aimed at healthcare staff working in the various settings where a child will present with respiratory illness, including home, primary and community care, and across the acute hospital environment.

Sexual / Reproductive Health Training

- **Essentials of Sexual & Reproductive Health**

This course, delivered by accredited trainer, provides updated information for current issues in sexual health, including contraception, sexually transmitted infections, HIV and teenage pregnancy. It is suitable for any Health Care Professional who has a role in delivering sexual health services.

- **Foundation Cervical Sample Taker's Course**

The aim of this course is to assist Cervical Sample Taker Trainees to maintain high standards of sample taking in accordance with local and national standards. Trainees will attend 2-day training with our Clinical Educators before completing the rest of the programme by undertaking supported procedures in practice with their Mentor. N.B. this course is not provided as part of the Primary Care Education Programme subscription and, unless an alternative source of funded can be sourced, course fees apply.

- **Cervical Cytology Update E-learning**

For existing sample takers requiring Update training, please complete the following modules on E-Learning for Health: Cervical Sample Taker Update module and Primary HPV Screening module.

- **E-Learning For Sexual And Reproductive Healthcare (e-SRH)**

This resource supports healthcare professionals in acquiring the relevant knowledge needed for delivering sexual and reproductive healthcare, supporting FSRH trainees to prepare for the e-Knowledge Assessment (eKA).

- **NHS Cervical Cancer Screening E-Learning**

NHS Cervical Screening Programme (NHSCSP) provides free of charge training hosted on Health Education England's e-learning for Healthcare (e-LfH). This meets the cervical sample taker 3 yearly update training requirements.

Menopause

We are developing an offer of training and support in this area. This will include individual self-help, managing staff going through the menopause and clinical training. Further details will be available soon.

Teaching, Assessment & Supervision Skills

Fundamentals & Practice of Clinical Supervision

Access to formal clinical supervision is a requirement of professional bodies to ensure service quality, safety and governance for patients and support staff resilience and retention. This training presents the theory underpinning effective clinical supervision and looks at practical aspects of how to deliver within your organisation, with a particular focus on clinical supervision groups. This is particularly suitable for HCP’s who are current/future clinical supervision group leaders.

FCP Roadmap Supervision

The FCP roadmap supervision course, managed regionally, is run virtually over 2 days. Contact us for eligibility criteria and next available courses dates.

There is also a Top Up Session for GP Educational Supervisors (GP ESs). This provides a supportive additional training resource to the existing GP Educator Supervisors training. This is provided by E-Learning for Health.
